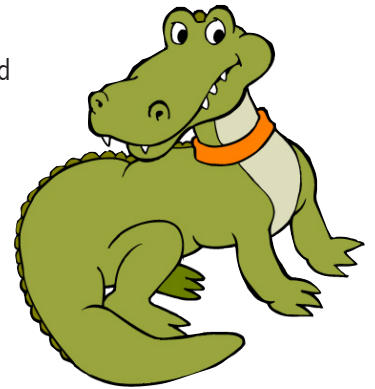
Home of the Gators!
